

## Teacher Mentor Teams: What are they?

- Teachers travel together to developing countries to facilitate week-long education workshops to provide opportunities for local teachers to improve their skills and learn new techniques.

## Who can participate?

- Teachers or teacher educators interested in having a global influence and with at least three years teaching experience are eligible to apply.

## Why are the workshops important?

- Education is one of the most powerful tools in reducing global poverty, yet often teachers in developing countries lack opportunities and resources to obtain higher education and improve their teaching skills. Some teachers have very little education themselves. The teacher workshops help fill the educational gap and empower teachers to improve the quality of education for their students.

## What are the workshop topics?

- Workshop topics vary based on the needs of the participating teachers and the experiences and training of the presenters. World Hope Australia will work with presenters to choose the team and topic that best fits with their areas of expertise.
